Safety Information

There are a number of **Orange Lines** marked on the ground around the property that indicate areas that guests **are requested not to cross or enter!**

When trains are operational, guests are requested to remain a minimum of 1.5m from the track. Please do not cross the track except at formed level crossings.

When riding the train, please remain seated at all times and do not extend any body part out of the carriage.

All guests are requested to follow any instructions given by any PHR volunteers wearing the Orange Tee-Shirts with the PHR Logo. In case of an emergency please follow the instructions of Supervisors wearing Blue PHR Hats.

Train Operations & Guest Rides

The current configuration of carriages at Pete's Hobby Railway is two carriages – one seating 9 guests and the other seats 6 guests plus two “crew”.

Seating on the “first official ride” will be reserved and assigned by Peter. Other Guests are welcome to photograph the train running at this time and then they will be welcome to ride the train on the various subsequent trips.

Rides in the locomotives are not permitted today.
